On 4th September 2017, an oil tanker owned by the company from the Thailand named MT MGT-1 has started a cruise from Rayong Port, Thailand to Phuket Port, Thailand. On that day, MT MGT-1 was carrying gallons of diesel (High-Speed Diesel) around 1,706,318 Metric Tonne. A total of 14 crew members followed the cruise on the ship owned by the Marine Global Transport Company Limited. All crews are Thai citizens.

Initially, the MT MGT-1 cruise runs smoothly for several days until the vessel starts cruising through Malaysian waters. On September 6, 2017, hours around 8.30pm, in Malaysian waters, one speedboat arrived at MT MGT-1. There are 7 suspects in the boat. 6 of them have climbed MT MGT-1 with armed machetes and knives. All of them wearing a face mask and one carrying a gun.

The further investigation found that 2 suspects who managed to escape during the ambush were known as JAWI UDIN and ARJUNA.

Additional facts of the case:

Before 6 of them got into the ship, Captain MT MGT-1, Bunchoo Sirimangkalo was able to press the vessel's emergency alarm system to inform all of the crew to be alert as the ship had been hijacked by a group of pirates and Ship Security Alert System for inform Thai companies and authorities that the vessel is in an emergency. When the six of them have succeeded in entering the ship, they have used a deadly weapon of machetes and knives to bring fear to the MGT-1 crew. All MGT-1 MT crews have been tied up and locked in the Mess Room.

After the MT MGT-1 ship was captured with his crew tied, 6 of those on board Neptune 09 @ Silver Elite had arrived at the right side of the MT MGT-1 vessel. Once you reach the bridge, six of you have then taken control of MT MGT-1 and then the MT MGT-1 cargo of High-Speed Diesel diesel is transferred to MT Neptune 09 @ MT Silver Elite using cargo hose.

At the same time, on September 6, 2017, hours around 8.35pm, Commander Maritime Commander Muhammad Suffi bin Mohd Ramli who served at the MMEA Headquarters received information from a complainant who was on his way back from fishing had seen a boat suspended by some in suspicious condition is climbing a merchant vessel named MT MGT-1 at 05 degrees North 38.3 minutes, 103 degrees 11.8 minutes East distance about 3 East BN from Yu Besar Island, Terengganu .

For that information, the Special Action Force (PTK) led by Maritime Bintara Ahmad Zairi bin Abdullah has been assigned to the scene. The troop had been on the scene on MMEA aircraft and had gone down to the MGT-1 and had arrested 10 out of 13 Indonesians on board the ship. One of them named SYAFRI was hide in a room called 'Cofferdam' which is a narrow space located at the bottom of the Neptune 09 @ Silver Elite, while the 2 others managed to escape by using speedboat. Malaysia Coast Guard are on the hunt for the two fugitives of the sea robbery case of **MT MGT1**. The two suspects are identified as Indonesian nationals, **Udin Jawi (Passport No: A6853158)** and **Arjuna (I/d No.: 82080003770)** by the International Police (INTERPOL) after issuing a **RED NOTICE** for them. The fugitives are wanted for the investigation of the robbery under Section 395 and 397 of the Penal Code (ACT 574) for gang robbery and armed robbery.
